Hendon MP Andrew Dismore was among the speakers at a seminar on Anti-Semitism held at University College London this week. The seminar, entitled Anti-Semitism and the law: fresh insights, was organised by the United Kingdom Association of Jewish Lawyers and Jurists (UKAJLJ) in conjunction with the Board of Deputies and Zionist Federation.

An audience of around 60 heard talks from Labour MP Andrew Dismore, ZF president Professor Eric Moonman, and UKAJLJ chairman Jonathan Lewis on the historical and political issues surrounding Anti-Semitism.

Moonman, who spoke on the same topic at an event organised by UJIA Manchester young leadership and the ZCC in Manchester on Sunday, said many people felt not enough was being done to rebut some of the arguments being put forward in the media.

Lewis said he hoped the event had provided participants with “a greater awareness of the clear and present danger of Anti-Semitism”.
